# 8. Water Storage Investment Program: Options for Available Funding (Action Item)

Commission staff will review options discussed at the November Commission meeting for the use of newly available Water Storage Investment Program (WSIP) funds and request Commission direction and decisions. Staff will recommend the Commission adjust the Maximum Conditional Eligibility Determinations (MCEDs) amounts of the Willow Springs Water Bank Conjunctive Use Project and the Kern Fan Groundwater Storage Project to the amount originally requested by the project applicants; adjust the MCEDs for existing WSIP projects to account for some inflation; and begin a screening process for potential new project proposals. The Commission may follow the staff recommendation, modify the recommendation, or defer its decisions to a later meeting.

# 9. Public Benefits of Conveyance Projects Panel Discussion

As part of the Commission's work on assessing a state role in financing resilient conveyance projects, a panel of experts will discuss public benefits associated with conveyance projects, prioritizing public benefits, and methods to value benefits.

## 10. State Water Project Briefing: Incidental Take Permit

Department of Water Resources staff will brief the Commission on the Incidental Take Permit (ITP) covering Delta smelt, longfin smelt, winter-run Chinook salmon, and spring-run Chinook salmon governing the long-term operations of the State Water Project and how it is being implemented.
